3. raise [Verb]

Sentence: Raise your hand up if you want to speak. Definition: to pick up or to place higher Synonyms: lift

pick [Verb] Sentence: We will pick the apples from the tree. Definition: to gather by plucking Synonyms: harvest

 Sentence: Can you hear my heart beat?
 Definition: to pulse with a steady rhythm
 Synonyms: pulse, palpitate, flicker, strobe

7. dress [Noun]

Sentence: My left arm got stuck in my sleeve. Definition: upper limb from shoulder to hand

9. train [Noun]

Sentence: We hear the train coming down the tracks. Definition: joined rail cars running on a track Synonyms: rail, subway, monrail

10. cross [Verb]

Sentence: Will you cross the street to the other side? Definition: to pass from one side to the other Synonyms: traverse

11. plant [Noun]

Sentence: A tomato plant is growing in my garden. Definition: leafy, green living things that grow in soil

12. star [Noun]

Sentence: He scored twice and is the star of the game. Definition: a standout performer or leader of a group Synonyms: winner, leader, hero, heroine, champion, victor

13. charge [Verb]

Sentence: The bull will run and charge at the red cape. Definition: to run or rush at aggressively Synonyms: rush, run

14. treat [Noun]

Sentence: Can I have a treat after dinner? Definition: something special like sweet food, a pleasure Synonyms: delight, pleasure, reward
